DESCRIPTION OF GROUP TOURS

1. MAUNA KEA STAR SUMMIT ADVENTURE TOUR

Thursday, March 22, 2012 • 3:10pm-11:00pm • Meet in Hotel Lobby

Enjoy an intriguing and provocative journey through space and time. On your way to the summit of Mauna Kea, which is 13,796 feet above sea level, you'll learn about Hawaii's geography, geology and natural history. You will stop for dinner at a historic ranch outpost, where you will enjoy a hot picnic-style dinner to include: fresh grilled vegetables with rice medley, your choice of paniolo beef vegetable stew or hearty vegetarian stew, and chocolate coma cookies (chocolate chips, cherries, almonds & oatmeal).

After dinner you will make your way up to the summit, where you will have spectacular views of Mauna Loa, Mt. Haleakala on Maui, Mauna Kea's world-class array of telescopes, and the famous Mauna Kea sunset. You will be standing on top of the world's tallest mountain, which rises from the ocean floor to more than 31,000 feet in elevation. In your hooded parka (provided to you), you'll stand in awe at nature's sublime creation.

After the sunset, you will descend back to the 9,000 foot elevation, where your guide will set up your telescope to view the brilliance of the Hawaiian sky. During this time, you will enjoy hot beverages and cookies. A naturalist will answer questions and provide educational information.

Cost includes: Round-trip transportation from/to Hapuna Beach Prince Hotel, naturalist guide, hooded arctic parkas and gloves, dinner (to include: fresh grilled vegetables with rice medley, your choice of paniolo beef vegetable stew or hearty vegetarian stew, chocolate coma cookies with chocolate chips, cherries, almonds & oatmeal, refreshments and hot beverages), tax, and gratuity.

Please note: Wear very warm clothing and closed toe shoes. You may wish to bring your camera to take pictures at sunset.

2. MOKU NUI SUNSET SAIL

Thursday, March 22, 2012 • 3:45pm-7:15pm • Meet in Hotel Lobby

The Big Island is well known for its fiery sunsets - the vog (a combination of volcanic vapors from Kīlauea mingle with the fog generated off the water) creates the illusion the sun is setting the horizon on fire. Enjoy this breathtaking, beautiful sunset while sailing along the rugged Kona coastline aboard the "Sea Smoke" catamaran. Keep your eyes peeled for that legendary "green flash" as the sun sinks below the horizon. Also look out for whales, as they may playfully escort your vessel. Relax as you listen to the sweet sounds of the Pacific Ocean while enjoying appetizers and the open bar.

Cost includes: Round-trip transportation from/to Hapuna Beach Prince Hotel, 2-hour cruise, appetizer menu (to include: cheese platter with crackers, chex mix and salami), open bar (to include: Mai Tai, Passion Pirate, Pineapple Express and other bar cocktails, soft drinks and water), tax and harbor fees.

3. BIG ISLAND SPECTACULAR HELICOPTER TOUR

Thursday, March 22, 2012 • 1:20pm-5:00pm • Meet in Hotel Lobby

You will take a 15 minute bus ride to Waikoloa and fly over to Hilo to discover the most geologically active environment on earth-the famous Kilauea volcano, which has been continuously erupting since 1983. The tour emphasizes the most current areas of volcanic activity with views of lava flows. You will fly over black sand beaches and see tropical rain forests along with cascading waterfalls. Experience all the awesome spectacle of Madame Pele's lava and volcanic badlands, then explore the lush rainforests of the Hamakua Coast. The towering sea cliffs open into the dramatically deep and meandering valleys of the Kohala Mountains. Beautiful waterfalls cascade thousands of feet into the rainforest below and remnants of ancient Hawaiian settlements are still visible. This is the perfect finish to the ultimate Big Island adventure.

Tour routes and sights visited may vary according to wind and weather conditions. Volcanic activity varies hourly.

Cost includes: Round-trip transportation from/to Hapuna Beach Prince Hotel, 2-hour helicopter tour, fuel tax and gratuity. **(Additional gratuities are at your discretion)**

4. SNORKEL SAIL ADVENTURE

Friday, March 23, 2012 • 9:10am-2:30pm • Meet in Hotel Lobby

You will take a short 10 minute van ride to Anaehoomalu Bay, where you will board a catamaran for a four hour snorkel adventure. You will start off with a continental breakfast, while sailing into a secluded bay of crystal clear waters. Relax on deck as you cruise the blue Hawaiian waters. You will snorkel among colorful reefs and exotic tropical fish. Explore a black sand beach created by the ancient lava flows. On your return back, a delicious picnic lunch and open bar await you.

Cost includes: Round-trip transportation from/to Hapuna Beach Prince Hotel, 4-hour cruise, guide, snorkeling equipment and instruction, towels, continental breakfast (to include: assorted muffins and pastries, fruit platter and juices), picnic lunch (to include: cold cuts, rolls, lettuce, tomato, onion, cheese, and pasta and Caesar salad), beverages and open bar (to include: beer on tap, white wine, soft drinks and tropical drinks), tax and harbor fees.

5. CIRCLE OF FIRES PLUS WATERFALL HELICOPTER TOUR

Friday, March 23, 2012 • 9:15am-11:00am • Plan to leave hotel no later than 7:00am OR 11:15am-1:00pm • Plan to leave hotel no later than 9:30am

This tour is the most geologically active environment on earth-the famous Kilauea volcano, which has been continuously erupting since 1983. The tour emphasizes the most current areas of volcanic activity with views of lava flows. You will fly over black sand beaches and see tropical rain forests along with cascading waterfalls while learning about the history and culture of Hawaii.

****Tour routes and sights visited may vary according to wind and weather conditions. Volcanic activity varies hourly.****

You must provide your own transportation (rental/personal car - maps will be provided on-site) to Hilo for this tour.

Hilo Airport is approximately a two hour scenic drive from the Hapuna Beach Prince Hotel.

Cost includes: 50-60 minute helicopter tour, fuel tax and gratuity. (Additional gratuities are at your discretion)
