AIR TRAVEL INFORMATION

The **McCarran Airport** is approximately **4 miles from Harrah's Las Vegas Hotel & Casino**.

Symposia Medicus has arranged for discount fares with **Alaska, American, and United Airlines** for this conference. Reservations can be made either through your travel agency or through the airlines' Convention Desk at the website or numbers listed here.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS

The **McCarran Airport** is approximately **4 miles from Harrah's Las Vegas Hotel & Casino**.

Below are three options for ground transportation:

OPTION # 1 – Taxis

- Taxis can be found outside the airport terminal and cost approximately \$25 each way.

OPTION # 2 – Bell Trans - *shuttle service from the airport*

- Runs from 3:30am to 1:30am, approximately every thirty minutes.
- As of January 2012, the cost is \$6.50 per person, one-way, and \$12 per person, round-trip.
- No reservations are required. After picking up your luggage, go to their desk outside door #9 of the baggage claim area.
- For your **return** to the airport, they require that you make **reservations** at least two hours in advance.

OPTION # 3 – Rental Car

- Symposia Medicus has arranged conference discounts with **AVIS** and **Budget Car Rentals**. Reservations can be made by phone; please refer to the conference codes below and the conference/airport location when making your reservations.

Both valet parking and self-parking at the hotel are complimentary. Valet parking is available at the hotel’s east entrance and self-parking is available in the South Garage, located immediately east of the main entrance.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS:

From *McCarran International Airport to Harrah’s Las Vegas Hotel & Casino:*

1. Head SE on Airport Departures toward Airport Taxi Depart
2. Slight LEFT at Wayne Newton Blvd
3. Take the ramp to I-15/I-215 Las Vegas/Henderson
4. Merge onto S Airport Con/Paradise Road
 - a. Continue to follow S Airport Con
5. Merge onto I-215 W via the ramp Las Vegas
6. Take exit 46 for Cheyenne Ave
7. Keep RIGHT at the fork to continue toward E Cheyenne Ave and merge onto E Cheyenne Ave
8. Slight LEFT at N Las Vegas Blvd
9. Make a U-turn, Hotel will be on the RIGHT



GETTING AROUND THE STRIP

Monorail Service

- The Las Vegas Monorail is a quick and easy way to get from one end of the strip to the other in about 15 minutes.
- There are a total of seven stops: MGM Grand, Bally's/Paris, Flamingo/Caesar's Palace, Harrah's/Imperial Palace, Las Vegas Convention Center, Hilton, and Sahara.
- The Monorail runs seven days a week, Monday-Thursday from 7:00am to 2:00am, and Friday-Sunday from 7:00am to 3:00am.
- The prices are \$5 single ride, \$14 one-day pass, and \$30 three-day pass.

Bus Service on the Strip

- There is a 24-hour bus service that travels from downtown to a substation south of Mandalay Bay Hotel called the Deuce. It is a double-decker bus and is the least expensive way to travel the Strip.
- The prices are \$3 each way, \$7 for a 24-hour all-access pass, and \$20 for a 3-day all-access pass.
