It is the sole responsibility of the guest to identify and obtain all required travel documents and have them available when necessary. Based on nationality, the U.S. and Canada may require an entry visa.

Guests who do not possess the proper documentation may be prevented from boarding their flight or ship or from entering a country, and may be subject to fines.

Note: No refunds will be given to individuals who fail to bring proper documentation.

The three hours allow you time for ship clearance, customs clearance (if applicable) and airline security. GROUND TRANSPORTATION

If you choose to make your own air travel arrangements, you can purchase Celebrity Cruises® transfers to/from the ship.
