PASSPORT AND VISA INFORMATION

- Use different credit cards to pay for each person booked.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION

If you choose to make your own air travel arrangements, you can purchase Celebrity Cruises® transfers to/from the ship. Once you have arrived and collected your luggage at the airport, you will be met by a Celebrity Cruises® representative outside the Baggage Claim area who will assist you with transportation to the ship.
