PREGNANCY POLICY

If a pregnant guest has entered or will be entering their 24th week before or during the cruise, they are NOT ALLOWED to travel.

MINIMUM AGE TO CRUISE

Children must be at least six months old by September 24, 2020, to go on the cruise. Denial of boarding for children who do not satisfy this minimum age requirement may also result in the denial of boarding for one or more guests sailing with that child. No refunds will be given as a result of the denial of boarding to an underage child or other accompanying guests.

PASSPORT AND VISA INFORMATION

Passport Books (not Passport Cards) are REQUIRED for every passenger including children and infants. If you do not have a passport, please allow a minimum of 4-6 weeks to receive it after you complete and mail the application. Your passport cannot expire before April 3, 2021 (or six months after your final date of travel).

It is the sole responsibility of the guest to identify and obtain all required travel documents and have them available when necessary. These appropriate valid travel documents such as passports, visas, inoculation certificates, and/or family legal documents are required for ship boarding and country entry and/or re-entry into the United States and other countries. Based on citizenship, many countries require an entry visa.

Guests who do not possess the proper documentation may be prevented from boarding their flight or ship, or from entering a country, and may be subject to fines.

Note: No refunds will be given to individuals who fail to bring proper documentation.

AIRLINE TRAVEL INFORMATION

Please note: Although the ship is docked in Venice on Thursday, September 24 and Friday, September 25, you must check-in beginning at noon and no later than 3:00pm on Thursday, September 24. Check-in will not be allowed after 3:00pm on Thursday.

You will fly into the Venice Marco Polo Airport (VCE), which is an approximate 30 minute drive to the port. You will fly out of the Leonardo da Vinci-Fiumicino International Airport (FCO), which is approximately 60-75 minutes' drive from the port, due to traffic in Rome.

If you purchase Air Transportation through Flights by Celebrity Program:

Flights by Celebrity Program allows you to purchase airline tickets at the best available prices. After you are registered and receive a reservation number, you can book directly on the website at www.celebritycruises.com/choiceair or by calling (800) 533-7803 and speaking with an air agent (service fees may apply). Any changes or cancellations may be subject to non-refundable service charges and additional airfare costs.

By using Flights by Celebrity Program, you can:

IF YOU MAKE AIR ARRANGEMENTS ON YOUR OWN:

If you make your own air arrangements, you should allow a minimum of three hours from the time your flight arrives in Venice to the time you must check-in at the ship (by 3:00pm Thursday). Although the ship is docked in Venice on Thursday, September 24 and Friday, September 25, you must check-in between noon and 3:00pm on Thursday, September 24. Check-in will not be allowed after 3:00pm on Thursday.

Going home, you should allow at least five hours between when the ship disembarks in Rome and your plane departs (disembarkation starts at approximately 7:00am). The five hours allow you time for ship clearance, customs clearance (if applicable), and airline security. You can also request to be one of the first groups to depart the ship by going to the Guest Relations Desk as soon as possible once you board the ship and letting them know that due to a tight airline schedule, you need to be included in the first group off the ship.
